To migrate or not to migrate. That is the question...

## **Two Options**

- 1. Upgrade in place (use update.php)
- 2. Create new site and migrate content




# Upgrade in Place

- Described in UPGRADE.txt
- Update to new Drupal core, contrib code
- Run update.php script
- Run update.php script again
- Run update.php script a few more times
- Will need some additional modules (e.g. Content Migrate in CCK)
- Problems with Features


### **Build New Site and Migrate**

- Build new site from scratch with content types views, etc.
- Use Migrate and Migrate D2D modules to move content over
- May need additional migrate modules for fields like entity references

### Build a New Site and Migrate?



#### Top 4 Reasons to Build a New Site and Migrate Content

- 4. Cleaner
- 3. Can get rid of unused modules and code
- 2. Much easier to deal with (features, dependencies, etc.)

And the #1 reason to Build a New Site and Migrate Content is...

#### 1. It's the Future!!!!

• Migrate will be part of Drupal core in D8



#### Migrate Modules

- Migrate module Will want version 2.6 or above so you can use...
- Drupal-to-Drupal data migration (migrate\_d2d) - Will want version 2.1 or above to use the migrate\_d2d\_ui module

### 2 Ways to Migrate

- Code write classes
- Pointy-clicky with a UI

#### The Future...

- 3 months after D8, D6 will be unsupported
- Many D6 and D7 sites will be upgrading
